Exercise 1 (Virtual Reality, 4 Credits)

- a) Form groups of four people and **either** try out the demo "Titan of Space" **and** "Lava" on Oculus Rift 2 device **or** watch a movie in the cinema theatre and answer the following questions in table 1. Each question corresponds to a factor thought to be correlated with presence, such as, for example: 'How much were you able to control events?' and from scale of 1 to 7.
- b) Plot box-and-whisker plots (using simple medians) for the data obtained from your group for each of the above questions and for the total score obtained.
